



SKILLSUSA AEROTEK SCHOLARSHIP

SkillsUSA has partnered with Aerotek to provide “**Make Your Mark**” scholarships to members. The “Make Your Mark” scholarship program supports the SkillsUSA Career Model to expand the talent pipeline and remove barriers of entry for members. Aerotek’s intention is to upskill the talent pipeline to improve economic outcomes for SkillsUSA members.

Based on the estimated costs of the educational program and experience documented on the application, students will be eligible for the following.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT: Up to \$5,000

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The scholarships are available to SkillsUSA members who meet the following criteria:

- Graduating high school seniors or college/postsecondary students
- SkillsUSA members in: Arts, A/V and Communications (Telecommunications Cabling only); Architecture & Construction; Information Technology; Manufacturing; STEM (Electronics Technology or Industrial Engineering Technology only); and Transportation
- Students who are pursuing further education and experience through a community college, technical college, apprenticeship, internship or certificate program
- Priority selection given to underserved students upskilling their current knowledge base
- SkillsUSA will award scholarships across all states as possible to create equity in distribution

SCHOLARSHIP TIMELINE

- April 3** — Application process will open
- April 30** — Application process will close
- May 1** — The scholarship selection process will begin
- May 30** — On or before this date, a SkillsUSA scholarship committee will review/select recipients and announcements will be made to scholarship recipients.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND DISTRIBUTION

- Students must apply on the SkillsUSA Aerotek “Make Your Mark” Scholarship application.
- These scholarships are not for four-year schools
- Distribution of the scholarships will be made to the educational institution for Fall 2023.
- If the student is accepted and enrolled in an apprenticeship program, the scholarship can be provided directly to the student (tax implications may apply).
- Scholarship recipients will agree to provide a written or video impact statement after receiving the scholarship.
