## >>> Update on the SkillsUSA Nov. 15 Membership Incentive

Advisors who met the criteria to get the 2023 SkillsUSA membership incentive received an email from SkillsUSA on Dec. 4. #### >>> Free Career Essentials for Potential National Officers

SkillsUSA state officers or other students planning to apply as national officer candidates are granted complimentary access to the SkillsUSA Career Essentials <u>advanced curriculum</u> or <u>adult learner curriculum</u>. Successful completion of the course culminates in the industry-validated <u>SkillsUSA Career Essentials Credential</u>. Students applying to run for national office who wish to take the course should complete this <u>course registration form</u> by Jan. 10, 2024. The course begins Jan. 12 and runs through May 17. Students have access to the course 24/7 and all coursework takes place outside of school hours. <u>See the course syllabus and general course implementation schedule</u>.
